MOECC Increasing EASR fees for Permit to Take Water

The Ministry of Environment and Climate Change (MOECC) is increasing the fees for registering on the Environmental Activity and Sector Registry (EASR) for your permit to take Water (PTTW). The original EASR fee of \$1,190 is increasing to achieve full cost recovery.

The new fee structure will come into effect on December 1, 2016. Details on the revised EASR fee structure can be found on the Environmental and Regulatory Registries at the following <u>link</u>.
